THE CHARLES S. COCK HOUSE MUSEUM

aka THE COTTAGE KITCHEN, 400 E. Hopkins Street

The Charles S. Cock House Museum, erected in 1867, is a modest, Vernacular Greek Revival structure and is the oldest remaining residential building in San Marcos. Although it is owned by the city of San Marcos, the Heritage Association has been a steward of the house for almost 50 years. Through the leadership of the Heritage Guild, HASM began offering Cottage Kitchen luncheons in April 1976. We are in the process of restoring this iconic building and plan to reopen our Cottage Kitchen lunches on these four dates in 2024: April 3, May 1, September 4, & October 2—the first Wednesday of those months.
