#### SPONSORSHIP CAMPAIGN

Months were spent in the fall of 2023 to develop a comprehensive Sponsorship Campaign that would be beneficial to our donors and to our organization—now and as we move forward. HASM is a small, community based entity with meager resources. We have modest budgets, use only volunteer labor and operate locally. We reached out to public and private sectors. Our fundraising goals in 2023 included the ongoing restoration of the Charles S. Cock House Museum which has been completed.

Non-profits want and need more financial security to build a stable funding stream. By encouraging donors to give once a year not only builds loyalty, familiarity and commitment, but we can plan our revenue better. Plus we can plan our year ahead better.

Large corporations determine their budgets at the end of every year and it's necessary to approach them early. Donors want to know what their contributions are supporting so it's important to communicate that on an ongoing basis. Our website now provides a simple visual that acknowledges our upper level sponsors. In-kind donors need recognition, too. All of this requires good planning through a well groomed Sponsorship Committee and Chair.

This team worked hard to create a sponsorship package that brought our sponsorship drive to a new level. They've raised over \$40K. Their aim for 2024 is to kick off the sponsorship campaign in August in anticipation of our 50th Anniversary in 2025.
