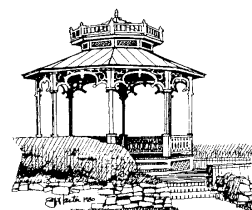

When: Saturday, April 16, 2022, 11am-1pm, Veramendi Park

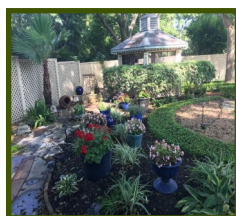
11:00-Registration, raffle rules, map of park activities

ELLIE STEWART

When Ellie and Harry Stewart planted their roots in San Marcos, it was 1971, just five years before the country's Bicentennial celebration. With five children under her tutelage, a fulltime job at the First National Bank of San Marcos, and a household to manage, Ellie had little time for volunteer work. Therein lies the difference in this matriarch's spiritual make-up. Ellie jumped in feet first to help with every Bicentennial project tossed her way. Looking back over the last 51 years as a member of Heritage, Ellie's contributions have been an endless list of heartfelt goodwill.

The many Heritage hats that Ellie has worn (always with pearls) include, but are not limited to, secretary, treasurer, membership chair, Guild member, home tour docent, Merriman Cabin volunteer, Cock House Museum hostess, Sights & Sounds corn shuck doll maker, dessert baker, lunch cook, ice scream scooper person, and Cemetery Walk contributor.

Born and raised in Mexico City, leadership and community giving were both qualities instilled in her at an early age. She attended college in the United States, married in 1951, and moved to New York where Harry was stationed as a pilot in the Air Force. There were many years during the war when Ellie managed the house and children on her own, a stellar tribute to her from anyone who has raised a family.

Their move to San Marcos was a blessing for the Stewarts, and, no doubt, the Stewarts were a gift to this quiet little river town. When you see the many ways that Ellie contributes, you are amazed at her abundance of energy and willingness to help. It stretches from family to friends, good neighbors to church, and San Marcos to nearby communities. It's a long, long stretch.
